Application for Scholarship

The Whidbey Western Games Association (WWGA) may award up to four scholarships per year of \$250.00 each. To be eligible for scholarship consideration, the applicant must be a member in good standing or the immediate family member, of a member, in good standing. The applicant must have a sincere interest in gaining further academic education or developing skills and training with the intended purpose of becoming a productive member of society.

These scholarships can be applied toward expenses for further education in any community college, vocational or technical school, two or four year college or university, or continuing education or educational retraining.

Applications are available from the WWGA website. Applications must be received by June 15th. Awards are made by the WWGA Scholarship Committee and will be announced at the June membership meeting. Applicants will be notified by mail of the Scholarship Committee award decision.

Along with a completed application, those seeking a Scholarship award must submit a letter to the committee containing, but not limited to, the following:

- Tell us about yourself
- Tell us about your WWGA experience, and
- Tell us about your future plans.
